Role Statement - Airport Facilities Works & Maintenance Officer

Job Brief

Mildura Airport seeks a suitably qualified and experienced person preferably with airport experience to contribute to the operation and progressive development of the airport.

The role will perform a wide range of airport services and maintenance activities to maintain the aerodrome in a safe and presentable condition.

Duties and responsibilities include:

- Maintenance and repair duties on airport grounds, pavements and facilities generally
- Inspections and audits as prescribed
- Operate light and heavy equipment including water truck, roller, skid steer, loader, grader, sweeper and other items of plant as required
- Pouring and finishing of small new concrete surfaces, cracks sealing and pavements
- Shoveling and raking dirt and asphalt
- Working on landscape projects
- Proper set-up of roadway and taxiway markings and traffic control
- Small maintenance and repair items including, but not limited to plumbing fixtures, doors, roofs, changing lamps/bulbs, painting
- Maintain the exterior and interior of facilities
- Removing debris caused from extreme weather condition
- Cleaning and maintaining tools and machinery after use
- Assisting employees and departments where needed
- Other project works depending on skill
- Responsible for personal safety and the safety and care of all equipment and supplies assigned
- Wildlife hazard management
- Aerodrome compliance duties
- Driving airside in a fully equipped vehicle listening, observing monitoring and reporting on all of the activities that take place
- Conduct regular daily inspections to ensure airport movement areas are free from foreign objects, wildlife, damaged surfaces and faulty lighting.
- Inspection of airside signage and line markings for wear and tear
- Work Safety Officer requirements required when airside projects dictate
- Heavy lifting may be required at times

Requirements

- Clear drug and alcohol testing
- Must be able to obtain an Aviation Security Identification Card
- MV license, preferably endorsed for heavy vehicles
- Ability to perform the essential physical functions of this position
- Computer literate
- Safety focused & must be able to work in a team environment
- Strong working knowledge of mechanical systems
